Scientific Cruise SO 314, 8. Weekly Report: 29.09.-04.10.2025

After the end of the station work, further seamounts were mapped on the way to Antofagasta (Chile) and a last ARGO float was deployed. During the transit most of the remaining sediment cores were opened, cut, described and packed into D-tubes for storage. The water and air temperatures decreased markedly along the cruise track, which made packing of the containers easier, in which, besides the equipment, almost 400 m of sediment cores from 77 locations hat to be packed into the reefers to be sent to Kiel. In the morning of the 4th October SONNE reached the harbour of Antofagasta, where cruise SO314 ended.
